assist youth directors in the planning process of youth meetings, fun events, mission projects, discipleship programs, fundraisers, summer programs, and all other youth-related activities

potentially take leadership over a specific area of the youth ministry and report progress and needs to youth directors

be devoted to your relationship with Jesus Christ, prayer, worship, reading of scripture, and church attendance

set an example to other believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity (1 Timothy 4:12) in all areas of life, including, but not limited to internet use, conduct at school, home, church, and the public.

be committed to living a holy lifestyle and abstain from sinful behaviors and activities which do not set a good example for other youth, including but not limited to drinking alcohol, smoking, engaging in sexual relations before marriage, illegal drug use, misuse of prescription drugs, dressing inappropriately or not abiding by Veracity Youth dress code, causing deliberate harm to self or others, and watching and/or promoting inappropriate movies, music, or other forms of media

holding peers accountable for living a holy and godly lifestyle and encouraging them to pursue depth in their relationship with God through prayer, study, worship, and missions

always show respect to peers, authorities, and adults
